A tribute to the arrangements of Moses G. Hogan, an award-winning classical pianist and native New Orleanian who began carving out an international reputation in the 1980's as an arranger and leading force in the revival of the Negro Spirituals repertoire. He directed the Mormon Tabernacle Choir in recording of this material and edited the *Oxford Book of Spirituals*, a standard reference work in the field. Among Hogan's numerous recordings is a 1996 collection of spirituals produced under the title "Elijah Rock."
